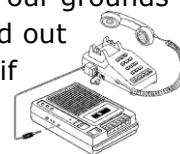
Unfortunately we start this newsletter on a sad note.

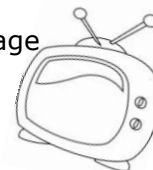


1<sup>st</sup> prize is the choice between an LG 42" HD Plasma Television or
